

**TRAFFIC IMPACT ADVISORY
PROSPERA VALLEY GRANFONDO - JULY 20, 2019**

The Prospera Valley GranFondo, presented by PwC, will take place on Saturday, July 20, 2019. This is a mass participation cycling event for cyclists of all ages and skill levels. To ensure safety for everyone — athletes, volunteers, spectators and motorists — the event will require some traffic pattern changes throughout the day and drivers may experience some delays.

There are 3 route options of 50 km, 100 km and 160 km and cyclists will travel through the Township of Langley, Abbotsford and Chilliwack. All routes start and finish at the Fort Langley National Historic Site and the event runs from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm.

- The Fort Langley National Historic Site will be accessible via Mary Avenue & Royal Street. Detour signage and volunteers will be in place.

Access to Langley Centennial Museum & BC Farm Museum

- The Langley Centennial Museum & BC Farm Museum will be accessible via Mary Avenue & King Street. Detour signage and volunteers will be in place.

Access to Businesses on Glover Road in Fort Langley:

- Businesses on Glover Road will be accessible via Glover Road as normal. Traffic Controller's and signage will be in place to ensure cyclists and vehicles travel safely.
